CLARITY REGARDING DISTRIBUTION OF MARKS IN CCE (CONTINUOUS COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION)

TERM 1

Formative Assessment 1 - Unit Test 1 + activities + short class tests
(10% weightage)

Formative Assessment 2 - Unit Test 2 + activities + short class tests
(10% weightage)

Summative Assessment 1 - Half Yearly Exams (30% weightage)

Total marks in the first term - 10% + 10% + 30% = 50%

TERM 2

Formative Assessment 3 - Unit Test 3 + activities + short class tests
(10% weightage)

Formative Assessment 4 - Unit Test 4 + activities + short class tests
(10% weightage)

Summative Assessment 2 - Final Exams (30% weightage)

Total marks in the second term - 10% + 10% + 30% = 50%

Total marks at the end of the academic session - 50% + 50% = 100%
