CLARITY REGARDING DISTRIBUTION OF MARKS IN CCE (CONTINUOUS COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION)

TERM 1

Formative Assessment 1 - Unit Test 1 + activities + short class tests (10% weightage)

Formative Assessment 2 - Unit Test 2 + activities + short class tests (10% weightage)

Summative Assessment 1 - Half Yearly Exams (30% weightage)

Total marks in the first term - $10\%+10\%+30\%=50\%$

TERM 2

Formative Assessment 3 - Unit Test 3 + activities + short class tests (10% weightage)

Formative Assessment 4 - Unit Test 4 + activities + short class tests (10% weightage)

Summative Assessment 2 - Final Exams (30% weightage)

Total marks in the second term - $10\%+10\%+30\%=50\%$

Total marks at the end of the academic session - $50\% + 50\% = 100\%$

CLARITY REGARDING THE PROJECT ON 'UNSUNG HEROES'

The children are put in groups of 5 to 6 students.

During the summer vacation they need to identify a person who they think are doing wonderful work for the society but are not thanked enough. It could also be a person, who in his/her individual capacity, is contributing to the society but not many people know about them.

Once the person has been identified, you need to interview the person, visit his/her home and talk to the family members and ask them about their aspirations, about their view on the life that they are leading, what keeps them working despite not many people recognize their efforts.

Then you need to make a four-slide presentation:

Slide 1 - The person who has been chosen

Slide 2 - Why did you select the person?

Slide 3 - What did you find out about his/her life? (If you have made a video of the interview, you may attach it to this slide).

Slide 4 - What you are the qualities that you admired in him/her?

The presentation dates are - 24th and 25th of June. The presentation will be made in the class during the zero period in front of the class teacher and the marks allotted are 10. The marks will be converted into grades which will get added to your co scholastic grades.
